DESCRIPTION

Music is a part of our everyday life. Today it has the same purpose as it had in the past – being universal language used for crossing the obstacles between different nations, countries, languages and cultures. Each individual uses music to build his/her own identity, meet other people, give support to others or simply explore their own musical possibilities by playing instruments or singing.

Music and singing as media for youth work – developing music skills of youth workers is designed to facilitate the use of music in youth work and intensify the networking of youth workers.

During the training course, participants will explore how to use music and singing in youth work, improve selfesteem regarding their own creativity, learn how to motivate youth and foster their creativity, elevate singing skills, learn about other participant countries music and develop new partnerships.

Training is going to be mainly based on non-formal educaional approach. Discussions, role playing, presentations, workshops, simulations, idea development and group work are main methods that are going to be used. Singing is going to be represented during the whole training hence verified singing methods will be used.

An experience trainer and singing teacher, Mr. Baldo Mikulić will help participants develop singing skills, using Werbeck method (more info: http://www.orpheus.hr/werbeck-metoda-pjevanja/3/)

PARTICIPANTS

Participants of the training should be experienced youth workers. They should also have some kind of formal or non-formal music education. Additionally, it is a great advantage if participants are skilled in playing instruments. If applicants do not have any music experience, they should have love for the music, willingness to learn and exceptional motivation for participation in the training and applying music in youth work.

Participants must be **fluent in English** (speaking, reading and writing) hence the official language of the training is English.

Participants should **be minimum 18 years of age**, with emphasis that **there is no upper age limit**. They should come from one of the 10 countries involved in the project: Romania, Turkey, Netherlands, Spain, Estonia, Bulgaria, Hungary, Lithuania, Italy.
